

FTGFOP 1

Very stylish, superfine, tippy, golden, flowery, orange pekoe. Maximum tip content. Sweet, mellow taste and orange colour liquor. This is a high quality whole leaf black tea, best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It is best consumed without milk.

TGFOP 1

Well twisted premium quality black tea. Fair amount of tips. Sweet, mellow taste and bright orange liquors. This is a classic whole leaf black tea, this is usually had black, with a brew time of 4 minutes, in boiling water. 2g of tea, in a tea cup. It is usually had as a high caffeine alternative to coffee. You can choose to add milk and sugar, or lemon -but it is also enjoyed straight. (It is like a stronger version of the black Darjeeling varieties).

TGFOP

Tippy golden flowery orange pekoe. Well twisted, clean, black teas. Stronger in taste and aroma as compared to the FTGFOP 1 and TGFOP 1.

It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It can be consumed with or without milk.

GFOP

Larger sizes of twisted black teas. Robust in appearance and taste. Aroma is not as strong as TGFOP. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It can be consumed with or without milk. But it is mostly enjoyed straight.

GBOP

Broken grades slightly smaller in size compared to FBOP, strong aroma & flavour. Bright red liquors. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It can be used with or without milk. But it is mostly enjoyed straight.

From Chota Tingrai won the silver award in the Assam black tea category of the global tea championship. The Assam gold is an exclusive small-batch tea from our p126 bushes in select sections of Chota Tingrai. We produce this tea for a very limited period during the peak second flush.

Assam gold has a sweet, fruity aroma, malty undertones to a nutty, golden liquor. It can be cupped with the winning teas at the 2019 winner's circle at the world tea expo. It would be best to pre-order since we expect 300kgs. Availability in June. Last year's Assam gold harvest sold out in 90 days!

FBOP

Broken grades, strong aroma & flavour. Bright red liquors. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It can be used with or without milk. But it is mostly enjoyed straight.

OBPS

Teas with a rounded shape, liquors are stronger than leaf grades but lighter than GBOP/FBOP. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It can be used with or without milk. But it is mostly enjoyed straight.

BOPF

Fanning grades used for tea bags. Bright colour, strong liquors compared to other orthodox liquors. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. We recommend it being prepared with milk.

BP

Assam speciality crush-tear-curl make.

Smallest of the leaf grades, bright, strong liquors and aroma. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. We recommend it being prepared with milk.

BOPSM

Smaller size of teas compared to BOP, brighter & stronger liquor than BOP It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°c), 2g of tea in a tea cup. We recommend it being prepared with milk.

CHOTA TINGRAI / DINJOYE

BOP

Round spherical ball shaped teas; light and mellow liquor compared to other CTC grades. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°C), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It can be consumed with or without milk.

PD

Used to brew strong, dark teas –ideal for filling tea bags. It is best brewed for 4 minutes in boiling water (80 to 85°c), 2g of tea in a tea cup. It can be consumed with or without milk.

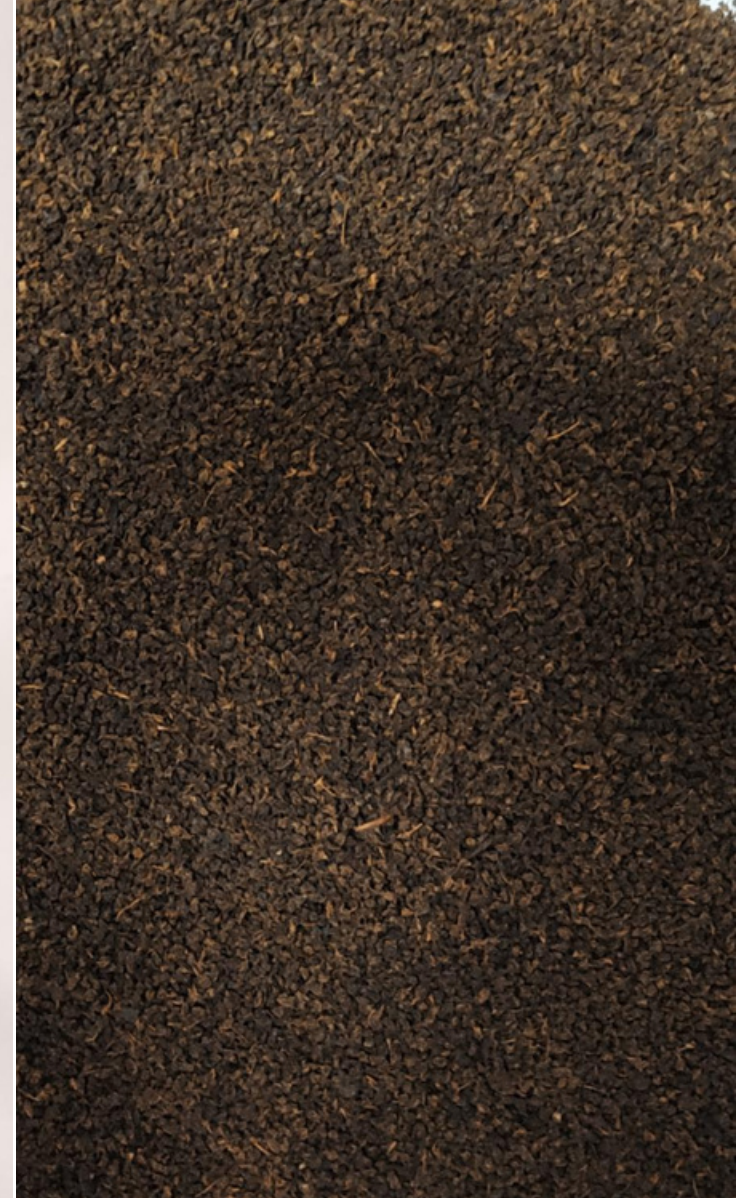

SUPERTWIST

Very stylish, twisted green tea, with strong, green liquor. This is a whole leaf green tea made by steaming the tea leaves, in the sencha (Japanese) manufacture style.

It is best brewed for 1 minute, in water that's 85*c, 1 tea spoon of the tea leaves (2g) in a tea cup. The leaves can be re-brewed a couple of times. Best consumed without milk.



FINE LEAF

Whole leaf, twisted teas with mellow green liquor. It is best brewed for 1 minute, in water that's 85*c, 1 tea spoon of the tea leaves (2g) in a tea cup. The leaves can be re-brewed a couple of times. Best consumed without milk.



GREEN TEA GRADE

GUNPOWDER

Rounded balls of green teas, stronger, green liquor. It is best brewed for 1 minute, in water that's 85*c, 1 tea spoon of the tea leaves (2g) in a tea cup. The leaves can be re-brewed a couple of times. Best consumed without milk.

FANNING

Small flaky tea leaves with light, green liquor. It is best brewed for 1 minute, in water that's 85*c, 1 tea spoon of the tea leaves (2g) in a tea cup. The leaves can be re-brewed a couple of times. Best consumed without milk.

GOF

Small flaky tea leaves with light, green liquor. It is best brewed for 1 minute, in water that's 85*c, 1 tea spoon of the tea leaves (2g) in a tea cup. The leaves can be re-brewed a couple of times. Best consumed without milk.
